These should include: transport links, FHODS/The Tower Theatre and possibly a storage yard for SPC. The group should also discuss how to lobby for the widening of the bridge. When Cllr Griggs had produced the draft proposals, an extraordinary meeting should be called, with invitations to Ben Geering (SDC) and Hod Birkby (KCC County Member) to attend.
