A member of the public spoke about the first application: Linda Rene-Martin had previously sent an email, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> July, in which she mentioned that SDC has a duty to inform about intrusive changes to historic buildings in the conservation area. In person, she said that she was against this application as it was totally unsuitable for the area and would destroy the back line continuity.

			We object on the basis of the rear roof changes being out of context with the terrace as a whole and give reference to the SDS 4 (page 50) that the proposal neither preserves nor enhances the character and appearance of the Conservation Area. Also with reference to the SDS 5 (page 51) referring to roof lines: the large rear window and balcony will increase the overlooking of neighbouring back terraces and the proposed mitigation of fencing and screens would also be out of keeping.
