

SANDGATE PARISH COUNCIL Minutes of a PLANNING COMITTEE MEETING Held at 7pm on Tuesday 15th October 2013

At Sandgate Parish Council/Library Offices James Morris Court, Sandgate High Street, Sandgate.

Prior to the start of the meeting, a member of the public requested to speak regarding a past application: Y13/0916/SH Pinehurst – the felling of a holm oak. Although the parish council had already voted on this application, and the local planning authority had granted planning consent, Mr Rae, owner of the property, wanted to explain his reasons for the need to fell the tree and the need to remove the badgers' sett. His comments were noted.
