6. Shorncliffe Redoubt

Cllr Whiffin gave an in-depth update of the most recent developments in relation to preserving the Shorncliffe Redoubt. In particular the council was advised of growing support from significant sources, including Richard Holmes of the Sandhurst Military Academy, Bernard Cornwell, author of the 'Sharpe' television series, as well as the previously mentioned producers of the 'Time Team' television series, due to carry out preliminary digs in the next two months. Also pledging support the Ministry of Defence in commissioning an archaeological report to establish historical importance, together with their offer of deployment of a bomb disposal team (if required) during such investigations. The Rt. Hon. Michael Howard M.P. also attended the site and offered his support and interest in the cause.

The Chairman thanked Cllr Whiffin for his continued work.

The Chairman Cllr Mrs J MacMillan opened the meeting at 7.00 pm.
There were 13 Members of the public in attendance.

- 1. Apologies for absence**
Apologies received from Cllr Mrs J Bailey & Cllr H Noonan
- 2. Declarations of Interest**
There were no declarations of interest.
- 3. Minutes of the last meeting**
The minutes of the meeting held on 10th January 2006 having been circulated, were confirmed as correct record and signed by the Chairman.
Proposed Cllr M Lyons : Seconded Cllr J Greenwall : Agreed unanimously
- 4. Public questions**
A ten-minute period was set-aside for the public to ask questions of the Council.
The Parish Council endeavoured to answer all questions put to them.
- 5. Chichester Hall Clock**
The Chairman reported that, as a result of public concern, the Parish Council had made extensive enquiries as to repairing the clock, which had been inoperative for some considerable time. The Chairman had received an offer of a free inspection and quotation for repair, from a company in Derbyshire who would be in the area imminently. The Chairman, in an effort to resolve this matter had also gone to great lengths to enquire about funding for such a restoration project. However, upon discussion with the Trustees of the Chichester Hall Charities Commission (a charitable trust), the Chairman had been advised not to interfere. The Parish Council had no alternative therefore but to hand the matter back over to the aforesaid Trustees for their attention, which it is hoped will be dealt with in the very near future.
