- 4.9 Toilets: an order was placed but the contractor subsequently advised that no units were available after all. Alternative suppliers are being sought.

GRANVILLE PARADE TOILETS

We are receiving frequent complaints about the state of the toilets mostly as a result of the equipment failing. The contractor has provided costs as follows:

- Replacement with internal element only: £1720 per unit
- Replacement of complete unit: £2740 per unit

Three units need attention and whilst the cost is high the RFO recommends that three complete units be purchased and installed. This would continue to be within the budgetary regime.

TWO YEAR INVESTMENT OPTIONS

The RFO has explored a large number of options to invest most of the PWLB in government protected two year fixed investments. The results are summarised below:

Institution	Rate	Comments
Bank & Clients	0.1%	No fixed rate investments on offer
Access Rate Bonds	n/a	Only for individuals
MetroBank	1.9%	One year only, would need to reinvest in one year's time
Raisin UK	n/a	Only for individuals
MyCommunityBank	n/a	Only for individuals
OakNorth	n/a	Only for private limited companies and limited liability partnerships.
Investec	n/a	Various options were reviewed but nothing was suitable for a local authority

In addition to the above a number of Sharia Law compliant banks were quoting competitive rates. However the nature of such investments do not appear to be genuinely guaranteed fixed rate.

Further the matter has also been referred to FHDC who are currently considering the possibility.
