- **Flags Protocol** 6.
  - The Union Flag currently flies daily from the Sandgate flagpost on the Village Green.
  - There are restrictions on the types of flag you can fly without planning permission, but there is a short list of additional permitted flags.

**Proposal:** to fly the following flags, from the list of those specifically allowed in the government guidance without permission, on the days named below:

- St George's Day 23rd April [St George's Flag]
- Armed Forces Day 26th June [Armed Forces Flag]
- Kent Day 26th May [Kent Flag]
- 1st June First Day of Pride Month (or Folkestone Pride March Day if held) [Pride Flag]

The Union Flag will fly on other days. This proposal is intended to be continue until amended.

If other days are brought forward, with flags that can be flown as listed in the current Government Guidance, and provided to the Parish free of charge, then adding those to this policy will be considered by Council.
