WHAT IS IT?

WHAT exactly does the event involve and WHY is it so popular every year?

Sandgate Sea Festival has been running for over 20 years and spans over two days, the Saturday evening and Sunday day time of bank holiday weekend in August. This year that is the 24th and 25th.

The event is situated along Granville Parade in Sandgate and welcomes various stall holders, musical acts and entertainment.

On Saturday 24th a road closure will be enforced and stall holders will be able to set up ready to welcome members of the public from around 6/7pm.

From 8-10pm our main stage, opposite the Rowing Club, will see live music with a break at 9pm for our highly anticipated free firework display.



The Sunday festivities are from 10am-4pm and are a fun day of live music, children's entertainment and market stalls, selling various things from crafts and candles to delightfully delicious foods from around the world.

Our 'Barrow of Booze' (pictured on the left) is a popular raffle prize, made up of bottles donated by local businesses and residents. ALL of the money raised is donated to the RNLI.
