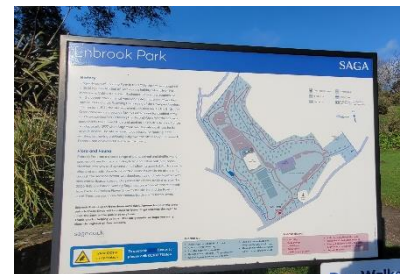


The Big Green Fair – Enbrook Park, Sandgate 7th June 2026 10-3pm

This event will be a family friendly day out and will be a celebration of all the great work that is going on in the district around sustainability, climate change and bio diversity and also of the beautiful green and blue spaces around us and the wildlife and plants that live in them. The aim of The Big Green Fair is not just for people to have a great day out, although that is important, but also to educate and inspire them to take positive action for the climate and wildlife and to explore all the green spaces around them.

Thanks to the kindness of Saga the event will be taking place in Enbrook Park, the extensive grounds that wrap around their flagship building in Sandgate. There is free carparking (although we will be encouraging visitors to walk or use public transport), toilets and plenty of space so the more the merrier.



We are currently compiling a list of stallholders so we can plan out the space and are also planning a programme of events that will run through-out the day which will include talks, children's activities, well-being sessions amongst other things. To help make sure people don't miss anything, all this information will be included in a Big Green Fair Programme which will be available on the day.



The event will also include the launch of our project Wild About Sandgate which aims to make Sandgate a Community Nature Reserve by encouraging people to make mini habitats in their gardens, balconies and window sills which will create wildlife corridors that will link all the public green spaces.

There will also be a carbon reduction zone at The Big Green Fair which will promote the council 'Switch Together' scheme plus information stalls for people exploring installing solar panels, air source heat pumps, and other ways that people can reduce their carbon footprint.



We will be advertising the event widely across the area through all mediums and from initial feedback expect it to be very popular. The Big Green Fair will be part of the national Great Big Green Week 2026 and will also be promoted through that.

Many people and organisations have already expressed an interest in being part of this exciting community event and to help us with our planning we now need firm commitments. There is no charge to have a stall as the event is kindly funded by

Folkestone and Hythe District Council's Green Grant Scheme.
